[**DECATUR, GA**] With thousands of homes affected across Georgia by the recent storms, DeKalb County Commissioner Lee May will host an emergency meeting to hear the concerns of constituents and provide on-site assistance on Wednesday, September 23, at the Lou Walker Senior Center at 2538 Panola Road, beginning at 6 p.m. in Lithonia.

“Homes were completely lost in the recent floods that affected families and businesses across the metro Atlanta area,” said Commissioner May, whose family was evacuated by fire & rescue team Sunday night. “I now know firsthand how it feels to lose everything and to seek answers without finding solutions. This meeting will bring together state departments, county departments and more to answer questions and help families through these tough times.”
