**COMMISSIONER LEE MAY TO HOST SPECIAL MEETING
TO HELP FLOOD VICTIMS, SEPTEMBER 30TH**

[**DECATUR, GA**] With the announcement that victims affected by the recent storms in DeKalb will be receiving Federal disaster assistance, DeKalb County Commissioner Lee May will host a special emergency meeting with representatives from FEMA, GEMA and the Red Cross to provide constituents with on-site assistance on Wednesday, September 30, at the Lou Walker Senior Center at 2538 Panola Road, beginning at 6 p.m. in Lithonia.

“The Federal disaster designation is just one part in the process of rebuilding homes and lives,” said Commissioner May. “We will have ample computers and telephones on-site so families and individuals affected by the recent flood can register for federal assistance. No one should leave this meeting without being registered for assistance and having their questions and concerns addressed by the proper government agencies.”

Representatives from DeKalb County, FEMA, GEMA, and the Red Cross will help register citizens for assistance. Additionally, local DeKalb County churches will donate various clothing and personal items for flood victims.
